Mr. Wong Tat Chung graduated in his first degree in law from King's College, University of London in 1985. He was admitted to the Bar of England and Wales in 1986 as a Barrister-at-law of Lincoln's Inn. In 1987, he obtained his Master's degree in law from King's College, University of London. He was admitted as an Advocate and Solicitor of the High Court of Malaya on 18 October 1988.

He is a Partner of Wong Beh & Toh and practices in fields, including, corporate finance, mergers and acquisitions and capital markets and other corporate and commercial matters.

He has been involved in both domestic and cross-border transactions.
